



Activity 1:

What's going on locally?

Learning Objective

To provide an opportunity for children to research the ranges of jobs in their area and help them to begin to understand people and places, and the work people do.

Entrepreneurship Characteristics

Organisation

Learning activities

Use a slideshow/PowerPoint presentation to show people doing different types of jobs. This is a good opportunity to challenge gender stereotyping and promote gender equality.

For each image, ask the pupils to discuss and identify the job and where the person works.

Invite people into the classroom e.g. school liaison police officer, school nurse, firefighter for pupils to ask questions about the visitor's job.

Visit the local high street for pupils to observe and record people doing different jobs.

Make a simple plan/model of their local area to show where people work and the types of jobs they do.
