## Activity 11: We can do it

### Learning Objective

- To carry out and complete an enterprise task using a range of organisation skills.

### Entrepreneurship Characteristics

#### Attitude

- Self-confidence
- Determination

#### Relationships

- Working with Others

#### Organisation

- Planning
- Managing Resources

### Learning activities

Pupils plan the practical arrangements for selling their finished product/service and agree and assign tasks. For example,

- preparing and practicing a brief persuasive pitch about the product(s)
- creating a clear price list and information about their product/service for customers
- making an attractive display.

The pupils should now be ready to begin trading, selling their product or providing their service.

Pupils keep a tally of sales and money received.

Pupils make a photographic record of their enterprise project.

After the enterprise activity hold a class debriefing session to discuss what has been achieved and what else needs doing.
