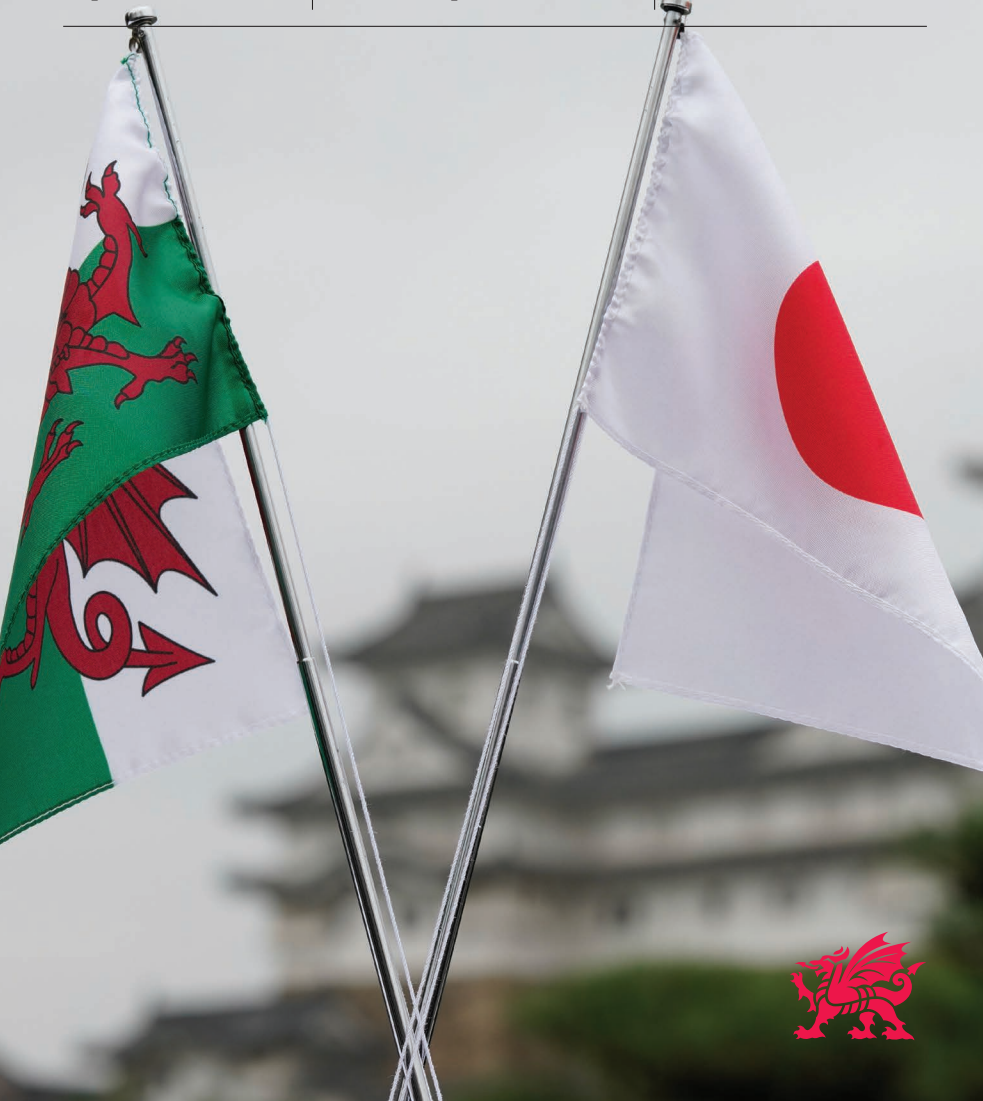

Over 80 million tonnes of MDF are produced globally each year and there is a strong demand to adopt this technology in the wood-based panel, furniture and construction sectors. Through the incorporation of recycled fibres into new products, raw material savings along with an improved environmental performance can be achieved.

Product/Service

MDF Recovery licenses its technology to recycle waste MDF and other panel board products. Target markets are the construction, furniture and waste management sectors. Globally, it is the first continuous fibre recovery process. It is modular, scalable and supplied through an exclusive manufacturing agreement.

Objectives

MDF Recovery's main aim is to raise awareness of its process technology within the wood-based panel board sector of Japan. Of specific interest are companies that manufacture MDF and softboard products used in construction, furniture and insulation applications. There is a growing global
