To enable learners to develop their knowledge, understanding and skills in the safe use and application of slurry and farm yard manure (FYM).

This is an integrated training and assessment course.

A Certificate of Competence will be issued on completion of this course.

You'll cover the following sessions:

- Understanding the benefits of Nutrient Management Plans and Risk Maps
- Consequences of not using and managing slurry and manures properly
- Legislation and guidance relating to protecting the environment and water systems
- The environmental impacts of slurry and manures and how they can be overcome
- Safe storage, transport and security
- Health and safety and dealing with accidents
- Spreading machinery
- Minimising ammonia emissions during application
- Working within NVZ's or near water courses
- The New Farming Rules for Water
- Record keeping

On completion of this course, you'll be able to:

- Understand the regulations regarding the safe use and application of fertiliser and manure
- State the relevant legislation that affects organic and inorganic nitrate use
- Understand product information
- Understand the operator's responsibility for safe working practices
- Understand the requirements for protected areas
- Take appropriate action to minimise environmental risk and protect wildlife
- Understand how to deal with an incident
- Understand factors to consider when using manure and fertilisers
- Correctly record information.
