1 Body Condition Scoring

Carry out regular body condition scoring (BCS).

Adjust grazing to meet pre-established targets at key times of year.

Forage availability

Overall availability of forage should allow for target BCS gain. Supplemental forage (and/or concentrate feed) may be needed.

3 Parasite monitoring



Use parasite forecasts and regular monitoring of faecal egg counts to ensure parasite controls remain effective.

Disease detection



Be vigilant for any clinical disease and proactive in investigation of infectious disease to prevent problems from recurring.

Trace mineral supply

Determine trace element needs ahead of supplementation.

Forage, blood and liver tissue sampling may be necessary.
