Properties of key sward species:

Grasses - high energy Legumes - high protein Herbs - provide micronutrients

Spring sowing MAY Deal with weeds prior to sowing Timing - warm soil, above 8°C JUN Light grazing and moisture JUL Cultivate / harrow to fine tilth AUG and broadcast sow if possible Autumn sowing SEP (if drilling ensure max 1cm depth) Consolidate! Roll, roll and OCT



Lightly graze 6-8 weeks after establishment to control weeds and encourage tillering
Be careful not to over-graze in first year; leave plenty of leaf on the sward for ground cover Rotationally graze for best results
Rotation length will be dependent on season and sward content
