Our Commercial Skills Programme addresses gaps in business skills and competencies, developing professional commercial management standards within the industry.

The overall objective of the Foodservice Programme is to support Welsh Food and Drink businesses to grow and create jobs by securing contracts into regional (Wales) and national (UK) markets.

The Foodservice Programme includes Welsh and UK foodservice, hospitality and wholesale sectors, to include Welsh and UK multiple chains and also independent establishments.

As well as providing direct support to Welsh businesses, the Foodservice Programme will also develop strong networks and relationships with the Food and Drink foodservice sector.

Protected Food and Drink Names

Getting your Welsh food or drink product recognised under one of the UK's Geographical Indication (GI) schemes can give it invaluable protected status. It confirms that it's a unique product, only produced in Wales.

The UK GI schemes, established following the UK's exit from the EU, cover:

- food, drink and agricultural products
- spirit drinks
- wine
- aromatised wine

Welsh Government is actively seeking to extend the portfolio of Welsh food and drink products which already have the UK GI marque, providing expert advice on how to qualify and apply for a place on this prestigious list.

Once there, you'll be able to supercharge your promotion with a high-impact presence online and at key events and take the next step of applying for EU GI status.



Export Programme

We can offer you one-to-one support if you are considering exporting as a way of increasing your turnover and profits.

Project HELIX is a pan-Wales initiative delivered by Food Innovation Wales, a partnership of three food centres based in Anglesey, Ceredigion and Cardiff. It supports Welsh businesses to develop innovative products from concept, design, development and manufacture, through to the consumer's shopping basket, helping businesses grow and thrive.

If your food and drink business is based in Wales then you may be eligible for Project Helix funded support. Eligible businesses have access to a range of technical and commercial support from Food Innovation Wales.

We can offer you tailored support, designed to meet your business's individual needs. We can work with you to analyse each step of your manufacturing process, identifying how to make your business more efficient across process controls, site design and systems development. You will be able to benefit from access to best practice and a range of industry intelligence, designed to make your business better.


Scale-Up Programme


