This Framework specifies the standards and criteria for the delivery of Level 2 and 3 training provision within the Advanced Manufacturing and Materials sector. Successful completion of the provision will lead to the award of a designated/regulated qualification(s) within the sector.

The Level 2 and 3 Apprenticeships are suitable for a variety of roles including key manufacturing, craft and technical roles in the Glass and Glazing industry

MANDATORY OUTCOMES

Achievement of these qualifications will be assessed by verification through the appropriate awarding body. Participants must complete:

- Either a competence and a knowledge qualification or a combined competence and knowledge based qualification from one of the following pathways.
- Essential Skills and the Employment Rights and Responsibilities as stated below.
