This Framework specifies the standards and criteria for the delivery of Level 3 training provision within the Advanced Manufacturing and Materials sector. Successful completion of the provision will lead to the award of a designated/regulated qualification(s) within the sector.

The Level 3 Apprenticeship is suitable for a variety of roles, including business improvement co-ordinators, lean manufacturing facilitators, production team leaders and six sigma quality and reliability co-ordinators.

MANDATORY OUTCOMES

Achievement of these qualifications will be assessed by verification through the appropriate awarding body. Participants must complete:

- Either a competence and a knowledge qualification or a combined competence and knowledge based qualification from one of the following pathways.
- Essential Skills and the Employment Rights and Responsibilities as stated below.
