# **OVERVIEW**:

This Framework specifies the standards and criteria for the delivery of Level 2, 3 and 4 training provision within the Agriculture and Environment sector. Successful completion of the provision will lead to the award of a designated/regulated qualification(s) within the sector.

The Level 2 Apprenticeship is suitable for a variety of roles, including Gardener, Landscaper, Nursery Worker, Fruit and Vegetable Production Worker, Cemetery Worker Greenkeeper and Groundsman

The Level 3 Apprenticeship is suitable for a variety of roles, including Deputy Head Greenkeeper, Deputy Head Groundsman, Garden Designer, Senior Gardener And Parks Officer

The Level 4 Apprenticeship is suitable for a variety of roles, including Course Manager, Landscape Manager, Head Gardener and Nursery Manager.

# MANDATORY OUTCOMES

Achievement of these qualifications will be assessed by verification through the appropriate awarding body. Participants must complete:

- Either a competence and a knowledge qualification or a combined competence and knowledge based qualification from one of the following pathways.
- Essential Skills and the Employment Rights and Responsibilities as stated below.
