OVERVIEW:

This Framework specifies the standards and criteria for the delivery of Levels 2, 3, 4 & 5 training provision within the Business & Management sector. Successful completion of the provision will lead to the award of a designated/regulated qualification(s) within the sector.

The Level 2 Apprenticeship is suitable for a variety of roles, including team/section leaders, floor managers, helpdesk managers and trainee supervisors.

The Level 3 Apprenticeship is suitable for a variety of roles, including first line, section, assistant, trainee managers, senior supervisors and junior non-commissioned officers (armed forces).

The Level 4 & 5 Apprenticeships are suitable for a variety of roles, including managers, senior managers, directors and head of department.

MANDATORY OUTCOMES

Achievement of these qualifications will be assessed by verification through the appropriate awarding body. Participants must complete:

- Either a competence and a knowledge qualification or a combined competence and knowledge based qualification from one of the following pathways.
- Essential Skills and the Employment Rights and Responsibilities as stated below.
