Apprenticeship Framework in IT Infrastructure

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The content of this Framework has been agreed and published by Instructus.

OVERVIEW:

This Framework specifies the standards and criteria for the delivery of Levels 3 & 4 training provision within the Digital Technology occupations. Successful completion of the provision will lead to the award of a designated/regulated qualification(s) within the industry.

The Level 3 Apprenticeship aims to provide the skills and knowledge required for various roles including Hardware Technician, Helpdesk Operator, System/Network Operator.

The Level 4 Apprenticeship aims to provide the skills and knowledge required for various roles including IT Service Manager, IT Network / System Manager.

MANDATORY OUTCOMES

Achievement of these qualifications will be assessed by verification through the appropriate awarding body. Participants must complete:

- Either a competence and a knowledge qualification or a combined competence and knowledge based qualification from one of the following pathways.
- Essential Skills and the Employment Rights and Responsibilities as stated below.

Level 4 Apprenticeship
