1 Pinpoint the Route

With various accessible footpaths and walking trails located all over Wales, unless visitors are familiar with the local area, they may not realise how close they are! Why not tell your guests through an email or a handy sign in your reception area?

2 On Your Bike

With less than 2%* of all journeys made by bike, why not encourage your visitors to cycle to you if they live close! You could also install bike storage space or highlight bike hire and equipment options to those staying for a holiday.

3 Time to Charge Up

Although an expensive option, if you have funding available, why not look at installing Electric Vehicle Charging Points in your car parking area? These can be used by your team and your customers as well.

4 Train or Bus?

Do you have public transport options within your area? Why not highlight them to your team and your visitors. By showing how close you are to a bus or train stop, it could encourage people to visit without the need to drive.

5 Get Involved

If you're encouraging your team and your visitors to make sustainable travel choices, you should be the one to start the ball rolling! Can you cycle to work, or even walk? Why not setup a car share scheme?

PURCHASE OPTIONS

Start small and install bike racks at your location. You can pick these up from cycling retailers across the UK, and it could be single stands or a whole rack.

Speak to your energy provider about the cost of installing an electric vehicle charging point. It doesn't have to be straight away, but you can then start planning.

Have a map in your main reception area with location pins for bus stops, train stations, tourist attractions and walking routes. Anything to encourage greener travel.
