




The Crickhowell Energy Zone

1. Description

The substation in Crickhowell distributes electricity to this part of the Usk valley including the settlements of Llangattock, Llangynidr, Cwmdu, Llangenny and Llanbedr. This zone also includes an extensive upland area of the Black Mountains and extends south-east to the border with Monmouthshire.






Figure 2 - Powys map

2. Potential viability of an Energy Local Club

There are five hydro generators within this zone and while relatively small systems, there are large enough to provide electricity to an Energy Local Club.

This area was one of the first to be approached by Energy Local as a community owned generator agreed to become part of the Energy Local Club and assisted with recruitment of consumers.

If in the future it becomes possible for an Energy Local Club to include multiple generators, this would be an ideal zone to target for expansion of the existing Club.
