




The Old Radnor and Kington Energy Zone

1. Description

The zone is a relatively large area of dispersed rural settlements between Llandrindod Wells and the Welsh border. Much of the Kington zone is in England and only serves a very limited number of Powys properties and can effectively be discounted. The Old Radnor area is almost entirely within Powys and serves a number of small settlements.

2. Potential viability of an Energy Local Club

There are no hydro or wind generators located within this zone to supply an Energy Local Club.

There is a single large solar PV system in this area, which is potentially large enough but generator benefits are likely to be marginal.

Recruitment of members would likely be challenging and require significant effort for engagement in several small settlements.
