In total during this week we made £183.90 The crazy golf course was attended by 177 people during the course of the week, a wide range of ages and abilities, some just staying for a quick game of golf, many taking advantage of the extra toys and games and staying for a lot longer. We all felt that it had been a fun week and something we would consider doing again as a small fundraiser that was relatively easy to organise. We all felt that having the addition of extra toys and equipment helped to make it more popular. In 2019 one of our groups Thumbs Up will take up the opportunity to raise funds and encourage the parent/carers of children who attend the project to take part and volunteer their time. They will be using any money raised towards a residential trip. Hopefully we will look to run this opportunity again in 2020 if still available.
