Lessons learned:	Worked well and was an opportunity to promote the venue to the parents/carers who attended as well as Contact A Family (national organisation) and Credu (local organisation) The workshops were received positively by parent/carers. Feedback from them was that information about transitions in children and young people lives had been very relevant to their children especially as for them transition is such a difficult area.
